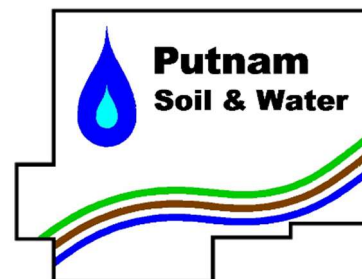


Putnam Soil and Water Conservation District Summer Junior Naturalist Program

Join us for 3 morning sessions to be immersed in nature. Professionals from ODNR, Hancock Astronomy Club and Putnam SWCD will be leading children into the environment to identify water critters, explore the night sky and learn outdoor survival skills. Children will receive an aquatic net, ferro rod and macroinvertebrate key. The program is open to students going into 4th - 6th grades. Participants must attend all 3 sessions and bring a water bottle each day. A maximum of 15 students may attend.

Attire: Children should wear water boots or shoes that can be worn in the creek and short pants for stream monitoring the first day. A second pair of shoes can be brought to wear after the creek adventure. Day 2 and 3, students should wear long pants and close toed shoes. They should have a back pack with other necessities if desired including sunscreen, hat, bug spray, and jacket.
