RECYCLING NEWS

Putnam County Recycling Bins will be moving to a drive thru in one of the back buildings in the Ag Complex. This will happen sometime mid-end of July. Bins will continue to be located where they were for the fair. Use the drive closest to the railroad tracks across from the Car-E-It's back parking lot. Follow the drive back past the first set of buildings. You will then turn to the left and go through a gate opening. There is a sign on a telephone pole to tell you where to turn. They will be open normal hours:

Monday through Friday 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. & 1^{st} & 3^{rd} Saturday 8:00-11:00 a.m.

Jeff Duling (Putnam County) will host the first Ohio No-Till Council field days on August 17th. It will be located on his family farm: 13079 Road 10-L, Ottawa, Ohio. The program will start at 8:50 a.m. and end about 4 p.m.

Would you like to have a highly functioning healthy soil? Our opening speaker, Adam Daugherty, will share his experiences on how to get a healthier soil to maximize crop yields and ecosystem services. As a Farm Production and Conservation Specialist with the US DA-NRCS in Tennessee, Adam has helped farmers succeed.

Jeff Duling will share the history of the Duling Farm and current regenerative practices. One of those practices is applying manure in season. Glen Arnold, OSU Field Specialist, will describe how liquid manure is applied to a standing corn crop, extending the time available for application and saving on nitrogen cost.

Do you have questions? We'll have a panel, including long-time no-tillers Les Seiler and Bill Richards (plus Adam and Jeff) to provide answers. After lunch, demonstrations in the field



will include: eight cover crop strips (Cody Beacom, Bird Agronomics); Soil properties (Jim Hoorman, Hoorman Soil Health Specialist); and Analyzing soil functions (Adam Daugherty). Cargill RegenConnect is sponsoring an Ice Cream Break.

Jerry Grigar will share how strip-cropping and cover crops on his continuous no-till fields have increased yield far above county average. He recently retired as State Agronomist for NRCS in Michigan. The program will close with an update of H2Ohio by Terry Mescher, Program Coordinator for H2Ohio, ODA.
